



2024-2025 Studio Policies

Scheduling Lessons are taught on a monthly basis following the [Providence Classical School calendar](#). Any deviations from the published schedule will be clearly communicated with students and their parents in advance of the change.

Absences Students giving 48 hours' notice before missing a class or missing due to illness of the student themselves will have the lesson credited towards next month's tuition or may join another class for a makeup lesson. Absences due to illness or with 48 hours' notice constitute an excused absence. Students are allowed a credit for three (3) excused absences from a scheduled lesson per semester. More than three (3) absences in a semester may result in the student's spot being offered to another student. Lessons canceled by the teacher will result in a lesson credit towards next month's tuition.

Termination Students wishing to end lessons must give the teacher two weeks' notice.

Tuition Monthly tuition is due on the first lesson of each month at the following rate:

\$27/violin class (up to 4 students per class)

\$30/30 min. individual lesson (one on one)

Payment is accepted via check, or PayPal (preferred method). Please make checks payable to Morgan Huneke. For PayPal, please provide your email address and you will receive a monthly invoice via email. PayPal invoices typically accept PayPal, Venmo, Apple Pay, credit, and debit.

Age Requirements Students must be at minimum six (6) years old and in 1st grade to begin lessons. This is to ensure that they are at a stage of cognitive and physical (fine motor) development necessary for their success in formal music lessons.

Practice Requirements Practice between lessons is a crucial part of music instruction. Students should practice a minimum of five (5) days a week. Recommended length of practice sessions can be discussed with the teacher.
